LESSONS WE CAN LEARN:

- A <u>CONTRITE</u> heart leads to <u>REPENTANCE</u>. It is essential to be forgiven and accepted by God.
- <u>RELIGION</u> does not lead to <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>.
- Only a <u>RELEATIONSHIP</u> through Jesus Christ allows man to be RECONCILED to God.
