A WALK TO THE CROSS (and Beyond)

The Plan Of God Ephesians 1:7-14 Easter 2017

I. THE <u>PREDETERMINED</u> <u>PLAN</u> OF GOD:

The cross and Jesus' sacrificial death wasn't something that was a surprise. It's been the predetermined plan of God that began with Lucifer's sin, along with the 1/3 of the angels that had joined with him, when they were cast out of heaven. With sin comes the need for judgment for that sin. With judgment comes the need for atonement... knowing that the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23).

• Scripture

Fulfilled prophecy...more than 300. Sacrificial blood atonement...

"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel."

"The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them...For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace."

But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our wellbeing fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the Lord has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him. He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, so He did not open His mouth...Because He had done no violence, nor was there any deceit in His mouth. But the Lord was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offspring, He will prolong His days, and the good pleasure of the Lord will prosper in His hand. As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; by His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities...Because He poured out Himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; yet He Himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors."

III. THE PREEMINENT PURPOSE OF GOD:

• Proclaims victory over death

"...Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting? The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law; but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

• Provides hope...eternal life

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead."

~I Peter 1:3

• Pronounces that He will return

"If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, you may be also."

LESSONS WE MUST LEARN:

- The ultimate reality is that God predetermined a plan that fulfilled His provision to provide <u>SALVATION</u>...the forgiveness of sin. It's not of man...but God and God alone (John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Ephesians 2:8-9).
- No one can save themselves. There is no one good enough to stand before God <u>INNOCENT</u>. No one is righteous...not even one (Romans 3:10). If you want to continue to try, then meet His standard of perfection (Matthew 5:48).
- We will all stand before God's judgment seat one day. You will either stand before Him <u>SAVED</u>...or <u>LOST</u>. He's going to separate the believers from the unbelievers like a farmer separates the wheat from the tares (<u>Matthew 13:24-30</u>)...and the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats (<u>Matthew 25:32</u>).

Ephesians 1:7-14

7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace 8 which He lavished on us. In all wisdom and insight 9 He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His kind intention which He purposed in Him 10 with a view to an administration suitable to the fullness of the times. that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth. In Him 11 also we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will, 12 to the end that we who were the first to hope in Christ would be to the praise of His glory. 13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.
