## 1. FOUNDATIONAL...BE FAITHFUL:

**Faithful**...Gk. *pistos*, means to be *worthy*...*worthy of trust* or *confidence*. To be *dependable*.

Both a **verb** and an **adjective**. Describes *who we are* and *what we do*.

"I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service" ~I Timothy 1:12

"O love the Lord, all you His godly ones! The Lord preserves the faithful."

~Psalm 31:23

Parable of the talents...

*"Well done, good and faithful servant. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master."* 

~Matthew 25:21

### 2. DEMONSTRATE SPIRITUAL MATURITY:

Able to feast on the *meat* of the Word...not just the *milk*. Displays deep roots of **faith**...*unwavering*...*steadfast*. Looks for...and seeks...the *deep truths* in the Word. Lets the Word of God determine their *values*...not culture. He doesn't live his life based on *religious clichés*.

"We have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words...But he who is spiritual appraises all things, yet he himself is appraised by no one. For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he will instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ." "I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able."

~I Corinthians 3:1-2

"Speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ."

## 3. WALK IN FORGIVENESS:

- Give forgiveness...Seven times seventy (Matthew 18:21-22; Luke 17:3-4)
- Get forgiveness...The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32)

• Forgive yourself...takes genuine repentance.

"Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." ~Ephesians 4:32

# 4. LIVE A LIFE OF HOLINESS: (Purity)

Holy...Gk. hagios, it means sanctified, set apart, pure.

"For I am the Lord your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy...you shall be holy, for I am holy."

~Leviticus 11:44-45

"...You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy." ~Leviticus 19:2b

"...You shall be holy, for I am holy." ~I Peter 1:16

# 5. BE A PERSON OF INTEGRITY:

Integrity...Means *complete* and *blameless...clear conscience*.

"The Lord said to Satan, 'Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man fearing God and turning away from evil. And he still holds fast his integrity...'"

~Job 2:3

"Is not your fear of God your confidence, and the *integrity* of your ways your hope?"

~Job 4:6

"God will not reject a man of integrity..." ~Job 8:20

"He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, and speaks truth in his heart."

~Psalm 15:2

"Vindicate me, O Lord, for I have walked in my integrity, and I have trusted in the Lord without wavering...But as for me, I shall walk in my integrity; redeem me, and be gracious to me."

~Psalm 26:1, 11

*"As for me, You uphold me in my integrity, and You set me in Your presence forever."*

# 6. DISPLAY GODLY CHARACTER:

Just as sports don't just *build* character but *reveal* character... so do *trials...testing...tribulation*. Godly character is *forged* through the *refiner's fire*. "...We have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God. And not only this, but we also exult in our tribulations, knowing that tribulation brings about perseverance; and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope; and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us." ~Romans 5:2-5

#### 7. EXHIBIT HUMILITY:

*"He leads the humble in justice, and He teaches the humble His way."* 

~Psalm 25:9

"When pride comes, then comes dishonor, but with the *humble* is wisdom."

~Proverbs 11:2

"The fear of the Lord is the instruction for wisdom, and before honor comes humility."

~Proverbs 15:33

*"Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled; and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted."* 

~Matthew 23:12

"...Walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love," ~Ephesians 4:1-2

"Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others." ~Philippians 2:3-4 "So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you." ~Colossians 3:12-13

### 8. BE ONE TO IMITATE:

"I do not write these things to shame you, but to admonish you as my beloved children. For if you were to have countless tutors in Christ, yet you would not have many fathers, for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel. Therefore I exhort you, be imitators of me. For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I teach everywhere in every church."

~I Corinthians 4:14-17

*"Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ."* ~I Corinthians 11:1 "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma."

~Ephesians 5:1-2

"You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit, so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia."

# FINAL THOUGHTS:

- **Don't lose your first love**. Be committed and still be in love. Your love for the Lord (Church at Ephesus) and your love for others...(Mr. and Mrs. Thomas in the nursing home after Mrs. Thomas had Alzheimer's).
- **Don't lose your worship**. Worship is preeminent for the believer. Don't let anyone or anything rob you of your worship. There is no excuse for losing your worship...other than a lukewarm heart. When one loses their worship...in reality, they have begun to focus on themselves instead of the Lord.
- Always walk in Grace. Temper everything with Grace.
